Enabling fans to scan their own tickets is the key to safe distanced entry at events. Our Contactless Scanning offering gives fans an immediate and intuitive experience, so they can can quickly validate their tickets and proceed – no staff interaction required.

In Self Scanning mode, the scanner is always ready to accept tickets. The configuration options are also pin protected so only staff can access them.

To keep an eye on your capacity, Live Scan Rate in TM1 Access provides an accurate view of how often fans are entering the venue and at which entrances.

How does it work for fans?

- 1. When a fan enters the venue, the scanner will invite them to scan their ticket.
- **2.** The Self Scan mode means fans simply hold their ticket up to the scanner.
- **3.** Once validated, a welcome message is clearly shown indicating the fan can enter the venue.
- **4.** If there is an issue, the scanner will instruct the fan to ask for help.
